

Friends of All Saints Terms of Reference

Purpose:

All Saints' Church provides a focal point for Great and Little Bourton for worship and also as an iconic feature of the local landscape. The 'Friends' come together to encourage funding and practical help to maintain its fabric and presence in the community, by raising and encouraging support in financial and practical ways.

Membership:

The membership will continually evolve and the aim is to draw in people from both villages who are willing and able. This group will operate on a 'self organised' basis with regular connection/communication with the PCC and will include at least one representative of the PCC.

Responsibilities:

The working group set up is informal and flexible and consists of members from the community to develop plans and coordinate activities to raise funds and be a focal point for community engagement.

Meetings

The working group will meet regularly to review their aims and to develop and plan community social events and activities.

Scope:

Help can be provided in financial and non-financial ways i.e. holding events such as a Strawberry Fayre, Big Breakfasts, a Christmas draw to a Church Yard tidy.

The group will determine such activities to support/target particular fundraising or practical projects.

Other members of the community are encouraged to participate and join working parties set up to deliver such events and activities.
