

Bell Tower Conservation project Great Bourton

...update May 2023

On behalf of the Parochial Church Council (PCC)

- Work has commenced!
- Quick re-cap:
 - 2019 costings re-tendered in 2022 when 95% of the funds had been raised;
 - revised costs increased around 100%, post pandemic affects/ material shortages;
 - scope of work reduced to prioritise that required whilst expensive scaffolding in place;
 - revised target of £72,300 incl VAT but without any contingency;
 - contractor, J G Restoration, appointed and price fixed for a May 2023 start (10-12 weeks work).

Going forward:

- The Parish Council have arranged for the clock face to be removed for renovation and replaced towards the end of the work to utilise the scaffolding in place.
- We continue with fundraising events and activities to reach the target and have some contingency also - when the roof is off we don't know what may be found.
- Please do be safe and mindful of the area around the Bell Tower whilst work is underway. Thanks for recent feedback on traffic and visibility this is being followed up and any update will be posted on the Bourtons' Facebook page.

As always, **thank you** for your continuing support and to Tom Bracke for his drone 'photos' - adding to the historical record of our Victorian bell tower.

New iNaturalist Project – Wildlife and Nature in The Bourtons

Do you ever see something when out and about in The Bourtons and think "what was that?"

The free to access iNaturalist mobile app and website both offer an easy-to-use system for identifying all kinds of wildlife - both flora and fauna.

Our new iNaturalist project will be used to extend the knowledge of our rich, local natural history, by helping to create an extensive species record for The Bourtons' Parish, i.e. Great Bourton and Little Bourton - our Wildlife Friendly Community.

Sign up to the project: you will be amazed to discover the variety of wildlife we live with.

How to join iNaturalist:

- Download the mobile app or visit www.inaturalist.org to sign up
- Record your observations Take new photos and add photos from your phone or camera and complete the brief observation details page. Make sure location and date are added.
- Share your observation This will help you identify what is in your photo, and it should be added to our project automatically.

How to join the Wildlife and Nature in The Bourtons (North Oxfordshire) Project community:

1. On the website:

- Hover over 'Community' along the top navigation, then click on 'Projects' underneath
- In the search bar, type in 'Wildlife and Nature in The Bourtons' and click 'Go'. Our project should appear in your results click on it. Once you're on our project page, you can join by clicking 'Join' in the About box and then Confirm. You will find a map of the project/parish boundary

2. On the app:

 Select 'Projects' and once you're on the projects page, search for 'Wildlife and Nature in The Bourtons' using the search icon in the top right-hand corner. Our project should appear in your results - click on it. Once you're on our project page, you can join by clicking 'Join' at the top of the screen and then 'Confirm'.

- They can attend a local Community Based Clinic
- Please contact us (details below) to book into a clinic and to provide consent

- They will be offered their vaccinations at School
